A Call to all churches in the Diocese of Down and Dromore to pray for our Link Diocese of Maridi

The first days on 2009 have been very difficult ones indeed for our link Diocese of Maridi, and Bishop Justin Badi has been asking for our specific and focussed prayers at this time.

A few days ago, LRA rebels attacked Nzumara village, three miles south of Maridi town. They killed seven people, destroyed properties and have taken over twenty people into the bush. The LRA rebels are a dissident group originating in N. Uganda, alleged to be backed by the Northern Sudanese Government to cause maximum disruption in Southern Sudan.

We can only imagine the fear and pain among our brothers and sisters in Maridi at this time. The world is very aware of the horrible atrocities which have been committed recently by the LRA in the Congo, but is unaware that they are very active at the moment in Southern Sudan as well.

Please uphold our brothers and sisters in Christ in your prayers, and especially Bishop Justin.

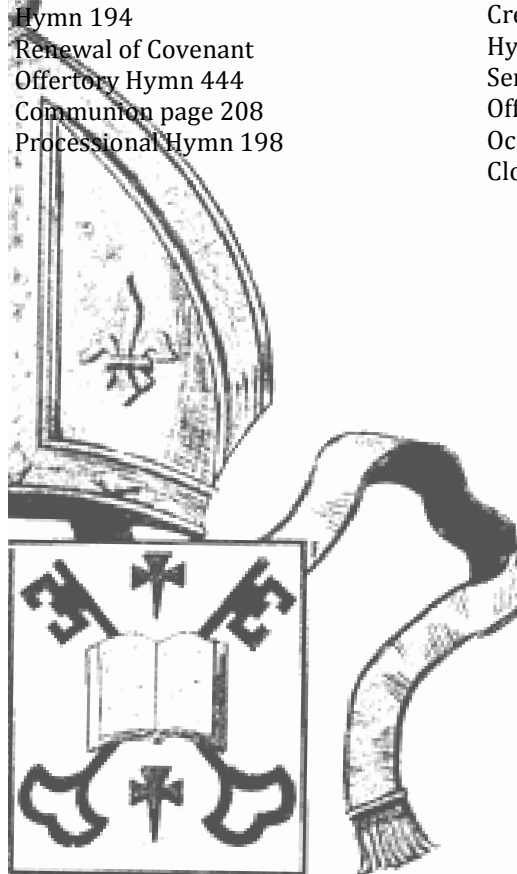
