Register of General Vestry Members

The register of General Vestry Members will be opened from 24th January until 24th February 2017 – during this time the register will be available for inspection in the Parish Office during the week and in the Church on Sundays. Anyone wishing to become a Vestry Member should obtain a Form of Declaration from one of the Church Wardens or contact the Parish Office and ensure that it is returned for inclusion on the register on 24th February 2017 at the latest. A review meeting to consider inclusion on the current register will take place at 7.30pm on Monday 27th February. In order that your name is included on the register, you must be over 18 years of age and have given in a recordable fashion to church funds in the year preceding the review taking place. Inclusion on the list of Vestry Members entitles you to vote at the Easter General Vestry, our annual meeting at which elections take place, vision is cast and finances are discussed. Anyone can attend this meeting, but only those included on the register of Vestry Members can vote or be elected to serve on the Select Vestry.
