Register of General Vestry Members

The register of General Vestry Members opened from 19th January until 19th February 2018 – during this time the register may be inspected in the Parish Office. Forms of Declaration can be obtained from the Church Wardens or Parish Office. Forms must be returned by 19th February 2018 at the latest.

A review meeting will take place at 7.30pm on Monday 19th February. To be included on the register, you must be over 18 and have given in a recordable fashion to Church funds in the year preceding the review taking place. Inclusion on the list of Vestry Members entitles you to vote at the Easter General Vestry. Anyone can attend this meeting, but only those on the register of Vestry Members can vote or be elected to serve on the Select Vestry.

Ash Wednesday

Lent begins on Wednesday 14th February at 7.30pm with a short reflective service in the Cathedral. During the season of Lent we are encouraging the church family to engage in the "Jar of Grace" project. Each meal time, we are being encouraged to pause, pray for and give to the work of Youth for Christ and Maridi Diocese, South Sudan. Jars are available in the porch this morning for anyone wishing to participate.
