## Register of General Vestry Members

The register of General Vestry Members opened from 18th January until Monday 18th February 2019 – during this time the register may be inspected in the Parish Office. Forms of Declaration can be obtained from the Church Wardens or Parish Office. Forms must be returned by 18th February 2019 at the latest.

A review meeting will take place at 7.30pm on Monday 18th February. To be included on the register, you must be over 18 and have given in a recordable fashion to Church funds in the year preceding the review taking place. Inclusion on the list of Vestry Members entitles you to vote at the Easter General Vestry. Anyone can attend this meeting, but only those on the register of Vestry Members can vote or be elected to serve on the Select Vestry.
